IKSV in **2022**

Qualified Experiences in the Field of Culture and Arts

İKSV events started in January with İKSV Galas screenings, and continued with Salon İKSV concerts, 41st Istanbul Film Festival, 50th Istanbul Music Festival, +1 Presents: Gezgin Salon Festival, 29th Istanbul Jazz Festival, 17th Istanbul Biennial, Filmekimi and 26th Istanbul Theatre Festival. As part of the special events organised within the scope of İKSV's 50th Anniversary, Zurich Ballet's Anna Karenina and a concert by Nick Cave and The Bad Seeds met with audiences.

In 2022 İKSV celebrated its 50th anniversary and reached nearly 800 thousand art lovers with its events.

Strengthening International Connections

Füsun Onur's exhibition titled Once upon a time... was coordinated by İKSV, and featured at the Pavilion of Turkey at la Biennale di Venezia. Istanbul Jazz Festival's Vitrin: Showcase for Contemporary Music from Turkey and the Istanbul Film Festival's Meetings on the Bridge programme helped establish links between artists from Turkey and international art professionals. This year, the Foundation resumed hosting young artists in its residency programme at the Cité des Arts workshop in France.

İKSV in **2022**

Support for the Development and Production of Artists

İKSV supported contemporary productions of art and culture with the Aydın Gün Encouragement Award, the Talât Sait Halman Translation Award and the Gülriz Sururi-Engin Cezzar Theatre Encouragement Award, in addition to commissions and production support within the scope of its festivals and the Istanbul Biennial, and the awards presented at the Istanbul Film Festival.

Additionally, through fundraising activities in Istanbul and London, the İKSV 50th Anniversary Young Artist Fund was created to strengthen the Foundation's efforts in enriching the life of art and culture Turkey, and to contribute to the production of young artists, who will take part in the festivals and biennials.

Cultural Policy Studies

İKSV's 10th report on cultural policies was published with the title Gender Equality in the World of Arts and Culture.

Policy statements were prepared, and efforts were made for the development of the field of cultural policies through cooperation and grant projects.

IKSV in **2022**

Activities to Increase Access and Participation in Culture

IKSV Alt Kat reached more than 2,300 participants with 125 events spread throughout the year, aiming to contribute to the artistic development of children and young people.

İKSV started using the Userway interface on its website to increase accessibility in communication.

With the support of the Eczacibaşi Group, which celebrated its 80th anniversary in 2022, student tickets for all İKSV events were offered for sale at 10 TL this year. 40 thousand young people had the opportunity to attend events with the student tickets.

IKSV Has Been Here for 50 Years

IKSV celebrated its 50th anniversary in 2022. An Instagram project was launched to share photographs, documents and memories from the archive, upcycling bags made from promotional materials of the past years were produced, and a podcast series featuring conversations on the relationship between language and culture was published. In addition, the SaDe Artist Support Fund and the 50th Anniversary Young Artist Fund were established to support young artists.







"Thread of Culture" Project




